The aim of our Citizenship sessions is to give children opportunities to develop skills of communication and to debate issues which concern themselves, their families and their community; to make informed choices and then to decide how to act upon them.

Skills such as:

- decision making based on knowledge and understanding
- debating techniques
- effective team work
- researching and preparing a case for discussion
- active listening to others
- sharing opinions giving justification
- showing empathy
- asking questions
- compromising to find solutions
- turning words into actions

With a view to:

- Actively making a difference to their community.

## Activities

The two themes we have chosen for our Citizenship activities are Water and Waste. Each one can be explored in a variety of ways and can be adapted to be suitable for children from Reception to Year 6. The activities are linked to the National Curriculum or QCA Schemes of work where relevant. We can come into school and work with you there or you can visit us at the Environment and Education Centre at Clay Lane, Bushey.
